Prayer Points

Our Church Family

- Please pray for Martin and for Matt as they preach through Luke 23-24. Pray that they will be struck afresh by the person of Jesus and the events of his death and resurrection, and that we as a church family will grow in our knowledge, love, worship and service of Jesus who is our crucified saviour and risen lord.
- Pray for our Sunday services. Pray that they will be spaces in which believers are encouraged and discipled and unbelievers hear the truths of the gospel and respond to the call to repent and believe in Jesus. Pray for the many people and things that are involved in making our services happen—that the Lord would strengthen and use his people as we serve one another and seek to lift up his name.
- Pray for our Easter services. Pray as we meet as a church and gather with the other Passion for Life churches that it might be a good time of celebration and encouragement. Pray that we will be bold in inviting friends, family, colleagues and neighbours to our Easter services, and that invitations we distribute in the local community will be well-received. Pray that we will have visitors among us who will want to know more.
- Pray for our elders and deacon. Pray that their giving of themselves in service will be motivated by Jesus who gave his life for his church and who calls us to serve rather than be served. Pray for wisdom, unity, love and fruitfulness in service. Pray for Matt and for other elders as they take a break and have time away over the school holidays. Pray that they might return refreshed and ready to serve in the new term.
- Give thanks for our current mission partners (the Balls here in east London, the Baldwins in Georgia and the Neales in Spain). Pray that the Lord might sustain them in their ministries and bring them fruit as they seek to reach people for him and build up his church.
- Pray for the new opportunities to support mission work that we have been considering as a church. Pray for wisdom for the elders as they make enquiries with different people and as we work out which to support and how. Pray that all these valuable ministries might flourish.
- Pray for our children, teenagers and students as they take a break from their studies over Easter. Pray for good rest and good fun, and for a greater appreciation of what Jesus did for them at the first Easter.
- Pray for the regular ministries of our church and for our outreach into the local community. Pray for a particular fruitfulness as Easter messages are shared and the gospel goes clearly out.
- Pray for our church family, particularly those who are struggling in this season spiritually, physically, mentally or emotionally. Pray that they might know the power of the risen Jesus at work in their lives.
- Pray that we might grow as a church in every sense—in Christlikeness and in number as lost people turn to the Lord.

Our Community

- Pray for the churches in our Passion for Life network, and for other local churches, particularly as they celebrate Easter, but also:
- <u>St John's Church Walthamstow</u>: as they continue to hold to the gospel in the complex situation in the CE, and for the new worker joining the team
- <u>Grace Church Wanstead</u>: as they do evangelism (pray particularly for the 'real hope' event with Martin Hull on 2nd), and as they pray for more (young) folk to join them and look for housing for their next pastor
- <u>All Nations Barkingside and Clayhall</u>: as new ministries such as women's Bible study, Chatty Café, Zumba and football become established, and as they seek to build up their eldership and develop their training
- <u>Grove Hill</u>: as they seek to move forwards in unity, grace and love, and as they get to know and incorporate new faces into church life
- <u>Salway</u>: as they seek to grow their children's ministry and gain more committed families, as they seek a new pastor, and for Ian Rees as he prepares for retirement at the end of this year

Our Nation

- Pray for our government as they seek to manage the nation's finances and reduce spending. Pray that savings will be made where possible but that the vulnerable and disabled will be protected and supported.
- Pray for our government as the Assisted Dying bill continues to be developed. Pray that all in the government will understand the God-given value of all life, including those at the beginning and at the end of life.
- Pray for our government as they engage in global events and conversations and manage complex situations and personalities.

Our World (provided by Open Doors and Barnabas Aid)

Pakistan—Give thanks for 113 families who have been freed by Barnabas Aid from the bonded labour in brick kilns that they had, due to debt, become trapped in. Pray that these believers will be able to lead godly lives and that God would grant deep trust, resilience and hope to those still bonded in the kilns and would provide funds that more might be set free.

Iran—Pray for 3 converts to Christianity from Tehran who have been given severe sentences (totalling 40 years imprisonment between them): Narges Nasri (who is pregnant), Abbas Soori and Mehran Shamloui. Pray for their health and safety, and for the safety of Nagres' unborn child. Pray that they will remain steadfast in their faith and that God would protect Iran's underground church and give strength and boldness to Iranian Christians.

Sudan–Many hospitals and health clinics have closed since civil war began nearly 2 years ago. Nearly 9 million people are now displaced, including many believers. Pray for an end to the conflict, for agencies providing emergency healthcare, and for God's protection and sustenance of his church in this difficult time.
